What is device management?

- A key task of any Administrator is to protect and secure an organization's resources and data. This task is device management. Users have many devices where they open and share personal files, visit websites, and install apps and games.
- They users want to use their devices to access work resources, such as email and OneNote. Device management enables organizations to protect and secure their resources and data.

What is Intune?

Microsoft Intune is a cloud-based enterprise mobility management (EMM) service that helps enable your workforce to be productive while keeping your corporate data protected.

- With Intune, you can:
 - Manage the mobile devices your workforce uses to access company data.
 - Manage the mobile apps your workforce uses.
 - Protect your company information by helping to control the way your workforce accesses and shares it.
 - Ensure devices and apps are compliant with company security requirements.



How does Intune work?

- Intune is the component of Microsoft's Enterprise Mobility + Security (EMS) suite that manages mobile devices and apps.
- It integrates closely with other EMS components like Azure Active Directory (Azure AD) for identity and access control and Azure Information Protection for data protection.
- When you use it with Office 365, you can enable your workforce to be productive on all their devices, while keeping your organization's information protected.
