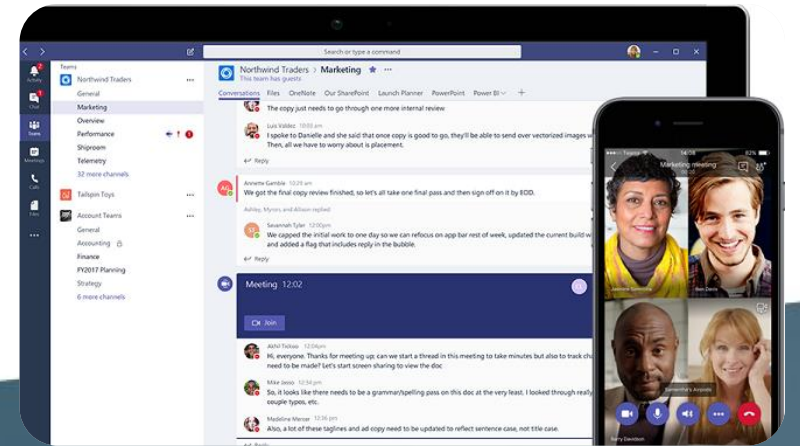

What is Microsoft Teams?

- Microsoft Teams is the hub for team collaboration in Office 365 that integrates the people, content, and tools your team needs to be more engaged and effective.
- Teams is built on Office 365 groups, Office Graph, and the same enterprise-level security, compliance, and manageability as the rest of Office 365.



What is Microsoft Teams?

- Teams leverages identities stored in Azure Active Directory.
- When you create a team, here's what gets created:
 - A new Office 365 group
 - A SharePoint Online site and document library to store team files
 - An Exchange Online shared mailbox and calendar
 - A OneNote notebook
 - Ties into other Office 365 apps such as Planner and Power BI

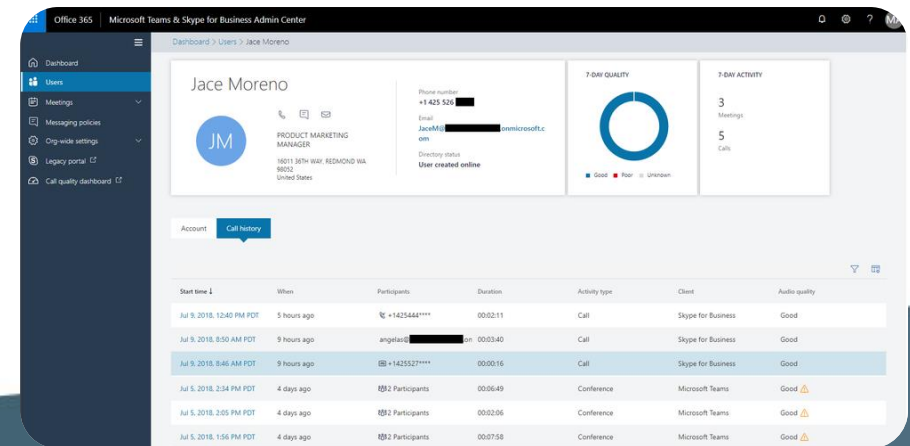

Teams vs Skype

- Since Teams includes all the functionality that Skype for Business offers, there's really no reason to choose Skype for Business over Teams.
- Teams lets you set appointments, mark events, share files, engage in video and audio conference calls, create groups, and perform numerous other tasks.
- All in all, Teams has become the ideal platform - a complete workspace package for optimized and productive collaboration.

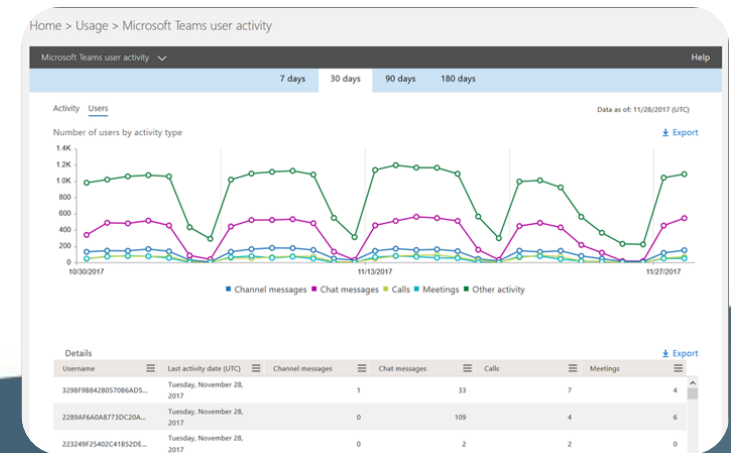
Admin Center

- You can use activity reports in the Microsoft 365 admin center to see how users in your organization are using Microsoft Teams.
- Your organization can use the activity reports to decide where to prioritize training and communication efforts.
